# The recipe...

# Cookie vegetable patch

For the cookie dough: 85 g butter. 1 egg. 85 g sugar. 150 g flour. 100 g plain chocolate. 1 teaspoon of salt. 1 teaspoon of baking powder.

For the icing: 10 cl single cream. 100 g plain chocolate.

For the chocolate crumble: 100 g softened butter. 100 g flour. 60 g sugar. 60 g almond powder. 20 g sugar-free cocoa powder.

For the decoration: 100 g of coloured marzipan, parsley or chervil.

1 square or rectangular mould. 1 hand blender or whisk. 1 oven. Baking paper Dried pulses. A rolling pin

1hr 30 mins preparation time: 30 mins

1. First, make the cookie dough. Mix the softened butter Baking: 15 min + 20 min and sugar using a fork, then add the other ingredients.

Stir until you have a smooth dough.

2. Spread the dough 1 cm thick in a rectangular/square mould, raising the dough around the edges.

Cover with baking paper, weigh down with dried pulses and bake in the oven at 200°C (thermostat 6-7) for 15 mins.

4. Make the icing: chop up the chocolate, then pour hot cream over it. Leave for 2 minutes, then stir until you have a smooth cream. Pour over the cookies.

5. Now make the crumble. Pre-heat oven at 180°C. 6. Put the butter and flour, sugar, almond powder and cocoa powder in a large bowl.

7. Use your fingers to mix the ingredients together well. 8. Spread the crumble mixture over greaseproof paper on

9. Bake in the oven for 20 mins at 180°C until you have a blackish powder (this is the "soil"). Sprinkle it over the icing. 10. Make small balls of sugar paste and roll them into sausage shapes but which are wider on one side than on the other to make half a carrot shape. The bottom should be flat so you can put it on the "soil". Use a toothpick to make a hole in the top of the carrot for a sprig of parsley to make the carrots' green tops. 11. Put them on the "soil". It's ready!


#### Posidonia plants:


Posidonia plants form a real underwater prairie and are considered as the "lungs" of the Mediterranean. Every day they produce almost 12 litres of oxygen per square metre. Posidonia plants are also an ideal habitat for fish, providing protection, a source of food and a nursery for the young.

#### The sea depths:

In 1934, the first deep-sea diving equipment was invented and the first diving club set up. These pioneers found animals and plants in their natural state. Today, all the coastal strip is listed as a Natura 2000 site. To explore the exceptional sea depths, there's pathing like making your first early.

# Did you know?

#### Hermann's tortoise

Hermann's tortoises mainly eat grasses (clover, dandelions, daisies) and can digest some poisonous plants. They also eat some invertebrates, such as snails, woodlice, beetles and earthworms.

The tortoises' drink comes mainly from their food, which means they can resist periods of drought. But in summer they sometimes walk hundreds of yards in search of a source of water.

#### Bats are useful!

Bats aren't very big (3.5 to 76 g, depending on the species), but they can eat up to half their own body weight in insects every night (up to 60,000 mosquitoes a year!). These creatures of the night help keep down the insect populations. They won't try to grip onto anyone's hair or suck their blood. All that is just a legend! They only like eating insects. What's more, their guano (excrement) is one of the best animal fertilisers.l.






